As a teen she took lessons with Michael Hurley at the Coleman Centre and attended sessions and local summer schools which influenced her to cultivate a rhythmic style, synonymous with the region.

is a traditional Irish musician renowned for his playing of the melodeon and accordion. He was born into a family rooted in traditional music in Connemara. He has won many All-Ireland titles on the melodeon at the Oireachtas and Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann. PJ has played with Shaskeen Céilí Band and was a founding member of The Swallow's Tail Céilí Band. He lives in Co. Sligo and has close associations with the Coleman Music Centre.
